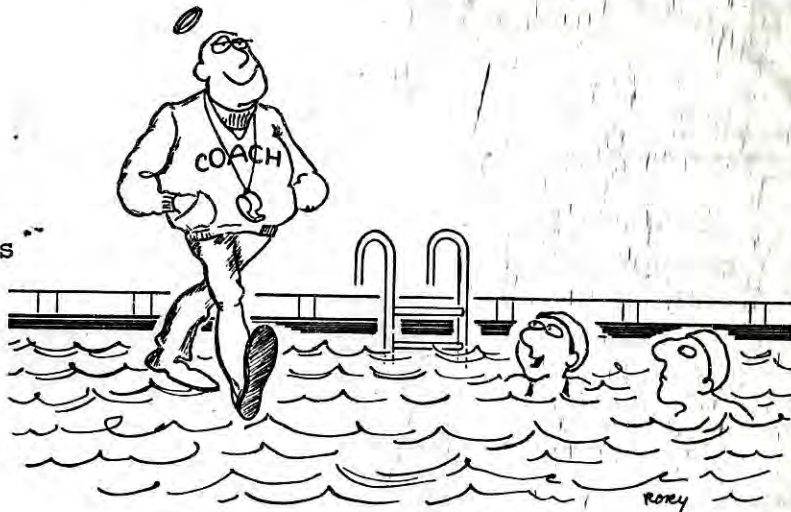
Regionals
