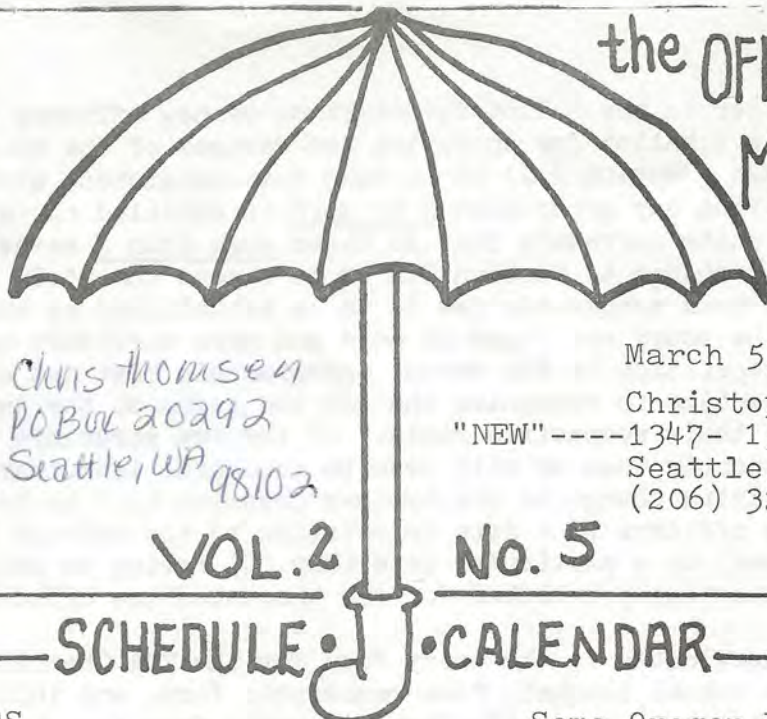

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Swimmers:

Included in this newsletter is the ballot for election of new officers for the coming two years. Also, included is a ballot for approving two changes of the by-laws of our organization. The first change (Section 2.2) is to make this consistent with the Constitution. The constitution states that any group with 8 or more is entitled to representation on the board while the by-laws state currently that it takes more than 8 members to have representation on the board. The second change to Section 2.2 is to remove the \$5.00 annual team membership fee and provide that the team membership fee is to be established by the Board. As the cost of trophies has risen, the board has found it more and more difficult to provide the six trophies for the team competition at the annual Championship Meet out of the team membership fee. It has been the practice to recognize the six top teams at the Awards Banquet with trophies to take home to their respective pools. If the fee structure remains as it is, there will come a time shortly when we will have to recognize less teams. This is not the wish of the board. The third change to the by-laws (Section 4.1) is to tie the balloting for PNA Masters Swimmers officers to a date in relation to the date of the PNA Championships, rather than (as at present) to a particular date (May 10) having no relation to how PNA Masters Swimmers has historically balloted for and announced new officers.

Also, included in this newsletter is the entry form for the PNA Championship Swim meet, reservation form for the annual Banquet, Team membership form, and individual membership form. Please note that there is a women's form and men's form for the meet entry form. Also, please note that the senior citizen membership fee applies only to those 65 years of age or older. All of these forms must be received by the March 30, 1983, deadline if they are to apply to the PNA Masters Swimmers Annual Championship Swim meet. Team and individual membership applications will not be accepted at the meet. We are expecting this meet to be the best and largest ever. We are looking forward to a fun, exciting time.

Since this is the last letter to the membership that I shall write as president, I want to thank everyone who has contributed their time, labor, and support to the organization in the last two years. There have been numerous people helping to keep the meets functioning the membership rolls accurate, the newsletters reaching the membership, and the bills paid. We have grown in numbers in the last two years as well as in teams and areas represented. This has been an exciting time for me to experience the pleasures of getting to work with and know you all better. I shall be looking forward to future times together at the meets. I also hope that you are as willing to help the new officers as you were to help me.

Thanks again to all of you for a wonderful two years.

The following are suggested word changes in the PNA MASTERS SWIMMERS by-laws, fo. sections 2.2 and 4.1. The ballot for approval of disapproval is below.

A. New language for Sec. 2.2: Team Membership

Any group of two or more paid members of PNA Masters Swimmers who are which is duly registered with the membership chairperson for the purposes of swimming as a ~~team shall be recognized as a team,~~ recognized team in meets sponsored by PNA Masters Swimmers, shall be recognized as such. Any team with ~~more than eight (8) individuals on its roster~~ eight (8) or more paid members of PNA Masters Swimmers on its roster shall be eligible to have its own representative sit on the Board of Managers with full Board privilage and ~~duties--provided that---the annual team membership fee of \$5.00 is paid.~~ duties; provided that: the team has paid the designated annual team membership fee in an amount as formally established by the Board.

B. New language for Sec. 4.1: Terms and Election Method

The officers of PNA Masters Swimmers, President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, shall be elected by the PNA Masters Swimmers membership to two year terms. They shall be voted on by secret ballot with winners determined by a simple majority vote of the members casting ballots. Elections shall normally be held every two years. Interim vacancies in any office shall be filled by a majority vote of the Board of Managers. The PNA Masters Swimmers Secretary shall mail election ballots containing the names of all qualified nominees to ~~the membership prior to April 10. Ballots to be counted, must be returned to the Secretary by May 10.~~ each paid member of PNA Masters Swimmers by a date at least thirty (30) days prior to the first day of the PNA Masters Swimmers Short Course Championships for any year in which elections are to be conducted. Ballots, to be counted, must be placed in the mail, or hand-delivered, to the Secretary by not later than one (1) week prior to the first day of the aforementioned PNA Championships.

Please cast your vote for or against the above word changes in the by-laws by checking the appropriate box.
