

## P. N. A. Board Meeting

June 17, 1980

The regular PNA Board meeting was called to order by Carolyn Behse in Judy's absence. Those present were: Cookie Justeson, Janet Twight, Walt Reid, Susan Dearborn, Florence Miller, Russ Hall and Fred Wiggin.

The minutes of the previous Board meeting were read and approved.

### Committee Reports

Records Walt Reid has the PNA Short Course Championships meet results and these will be published in the next newsletter. He reports that 46 individual PNA records and 10 relay records were set at that meet.

Newsletter Florence Miller is now in charge of the newsletter. She hopes to get the next newsletter out by July 3. Information regarding the Long Course Nationals should appear in the next newsletter.

Community Service Janet Twight reported on the CAPRI Relay meet scheduled for sometime in September. There is a possibility of Seattle Swim Club sponsoring this meet. The meet will last a maximum of 2 hours and a \$5.00 entry fee will be charged with 50% of the total going to CAPRI. It was decided by the board that CAPRI be asked to make arrangements for 3 hours pool time on a Saturday in September.

Meets A total of \$248 in entry fees were collected at the Enumclaw meet. A letter of appreciation will be sent to LeRoy Babbit and the Enumclaw Dolphins. A total of 71 swimmers attended the meet.

The next meet is Sunday, August 10th at the Bellevue Athletic Club. Warm-ups at 7:30 and 8:30 starting time has been set. This is a 50 meter pool and our only Seattle area Long Course meet this summer. The Region XII Long Course Championships will be held at Mt. Hood, Ore., August 15, 16, & 17. PNA members are urged to attend.

### Old Business

Janet Twight reported on the swimming portion of the Senior Sports Festival sponsored by Seattle Parks Department. She was generally disappointed in the low level of expectation the Parks Department had for Senior swimmers. The Masters who participated found the distances and competition quite easy.

At Janets suggestion, the board agreed to allow unattached swimmers to swim together as a team on realys. Any group of 4 swimmers may try for a record with permission from their
