Information was circulated on the Silver Lake Swim, August 23 and sponsored by the City of Everett Masters Swim Program.

Records: Walt Reid reports that a total of 55 new Long Course records (PNA records) were set at the BAC meet.

Team Wear: Russ Hall has offered to assist Heather Oesting with this job. Suits, caps, goggles etc. should be available at our next meet.

New Business: The CAPRI fund-raiser is re-scheduled for February 1980.
