

# PNA MASTERS BOARD MEETING

March 16, 1982

## Committee Reports:

Community Service Jan Twight said Capri realized \$ 160.-- from the relay meet the PNA sponsored in Fed. Next year Jan suggested we do the Capri relays in September.

Awards Dave Addleman reported that \$ 82.50 was made from the medals at the last meet and 8 were given to seniors. We will have 6 teams, who are paid up, to give awards to at the banquet.

Records & Top Ten Walt reported 16 records set at the Redmond pool march 14. The certificates for PNA and Top Ten records are ready to be handed out at the banquet. Also the PNA Handbooks are ready. Harry Lewis of the IEA keeps regional records updated and does a master list of same. Marion Muller set 4 reg. and 1 PNA record after turning 70 this year.

Membership Cookie asked the board if she should write to people who have not sent checks along with PNA registration and ask them to please send in the money due. This was approved. Russ suggested we drop the subject of unregistered swimmers until April. 12 teams are paid up and individual membership is at 251.

Newsletter Chris has the newsletter at the printer. The names of age groups relay team captains will be in the April newsletter.

Meets We still need a meetchairperson. In the meantime Jim Miles will ask Klaus Shaves about sponsoring a L.C. meet at the B A C in June. The Tacoma South End pool for July meet is a possibility.

New Business Kathy Brooks brought to the attention of the board the discrepancies in timing at the Redmond meet. A question of whether meet directors should brief timers and synchronize watches before a meet was raised. Kathy especially asked that timers be asked not to yell at swimmers on the blocks as this is disconcerting.
