

PNA MASTERS BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 3, 1982

COMMITTEE REPORTS were as follows:

Awards - Dave is ordering medals for Short Course meets.

Meets - Chet Palmer presented for the 1982-83 SC season the clubs asking for meets. The schedule agreed upon is as follows: Oct.- Kent Area Dolphins or Rainier Valley, Nov. - Bangor, Dec.- Evergreen High School pool, Jan.- Cascade Swim Team,- Feb.- Capri, Mar. - Evergreen College,- April - University of Wash. May is reserved for Regional and National Short Course Meets. June was left open.

New Business - Russ reported that the National Board of Governors of USMS will be held Oct. 3 and 4. The board approved Russ as the PNA delegate. Jan Twight moved we support 1 or 2 delegates financially up to \$550 to go to the meeting. The motion passed. Russ will attend the Wednesday Sept. 29th meeting also.

Old Business Debbie Lewis has a good start on LC relays at Nationals. 46 teams have been made up. After discussion it was decided that Debbie would advise the age group captains for the relays to notify people individually about their relays.
