

PNA BOARD MEETING

October 19, 1982

A regular meeting of the PNA Board was called to order by President Russ Hall. In the absence of Florence Miller Russ read the minutes which were approved as read. Vice-President Jim Miles took the minutes. Treasurer's Report - Bill reports we're in good shape for this time of year and we won't have to raise dues.

Meets - Russ gave a report on meets. The Capri meet having been changed to Oct. the Nov. is at Bangor. December meet is Husky Swim Club at the Foster Pool; Jan. at the Shoreline Pool sponsored by CSC; Feb. is at Kent-Meridian with the Kent Area Dolphins; March is at the Evergreen College Pool in Olympia; April is at Hec. Edmundson for the PNA Championships; Regionals are in Oregon in May; Nationals at Fort Lauderdale the latter part of May, 1983.

Newsletter - Attempts will be made to avoid placing meet entry forms back to back on the same page of the newsletters.

Membership - 429 registered members is what Marietta reported as of date prior to this meeting. People applying for PNA membership in October will have their applications made affective Nov. 1 and get 2 months of '82 membership in their 1983 membership.

Records - Walt has PNA L.C. and S.C. records up to date as well as Region XII top 10 for '81-'82. He also has Reg. XII records and L.C. National results which have been sent to him.

Team Wear - Russ sold \$100 worth of stuff at Nationals.

Sunshine - Guidelines for gifts or flowers for people in need (in hospital, etc.) Consensus was that \$25.00 is a good amount to spend. We'll discuss guidelines idea at the next meeting.

Community Service - Jan Twightsaid 49 swimmers attended the CAPRI Relays. CAPRI was pleased with the turnout which was the best ever. Jan encouraged us to vote "Pro Parks" on Nov. 2nd.

President's Report - Russ feels PNA is now in really good shape, particularly in comparison to other associations. Penn Mutual has severed its relationship with USMS as of 12-31-82. (Russ' report will be typed up and appended to these minutes.)

New Business - Stroke and Technique Clinic: Some swimmers have expressed an interest in this. A possible date for one would be Nov. 21 at Hec. Ed. Concerning the PNA Championships, the consensus is that a Sat and Sun. meet is the way to go with the 400 IM and the 1650 free put in appropriately.
