

PNA BOARD MEETING

May 3, 1983

The minutes of the April 12, 1983 meeting were read and approved.

Committee Reports:

Meets: Leif is still working on the meet packet. The bids for meets will be in the June newsletter. The PNA will try to hold meets on the 3rd weekend of the month except in December. Cathy Crandall is designing a new entry card. Starting this fall, everyone will have to fill out and send in to the meet their own entry cards. The meet committee will decide how to distribute the cards and will decide on the new design.

Newsletter: Rick Ingram reported that his parents can print the newsletter for a maximum of \$205.00 of 5 double sided pages. Every extra page is \$2.50 for typing and \$7.00 for every extra 2-sided printed page. This includes layout, typing, printing and mailing. Rick needs a list of labels or membership. Rick will be the person to send information for the newsletter to. Susan Allen will be the person who will plan ahead and decide what needs to be in which newsletter. The June newsletter will contain: Entry for Long Course Regionals in Spokane, meet bids, Volunteer requests for relays at Regionals, name and address (Kiko's) to send times for the relays, information on Nationals in Indianapolis, Information on Oregon Long Course meet, Coordinator for L.C. Nationals and a help wanted column. The standard deadline will be the 1st of every month to submit things to Rick. The newsletter will be in the mail by the 10th of every month. A letter will be sent to Almar Graphic Press thanking them for their printing assistance.

Membership: 430 members as of May 4, 1983. Last year in October there were 429 members.

Treasurer: We are \$2,000 ahead of last year.

Travel and Social: Time to start thinking about next year's banquet.

Old Business: Jeff Bowles will work with Joann Breslin on developing a stroke clinic. There is a possibility that the Stanford swim coach might fly up here to do a clinic if we pay travel costs.

New Business: At the regional meeting in Beaverton it was found that Oregon and the PNA are the only associations holding regular meets. Oregon will take the 1st weekend and the PNA will take the 3rd weekend for meets. Oregon will host the 1984 Regional Long Course meet if the PNA asks them to do so. The PNA will be hosting the 1984 Regional Short Course meet.

The PNA regional Championships will be April 7 and 8, 1984.

The regional Short Course championships will be May 4,5,6,1984.

The long course championships will be in Spokane August 12, 13, 14, 1983.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
