THIS MEET WILL RUN AS A COMBINED MEET WITH A USA SWIMMING MEET. THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY ONLY TO ATHLETES COMPETING AS USMS ATHLETE MEMBERS.

ANY ATHLETE WHO IS A MEMBER OF BOTH ORGANIZATIONS MUST SELECT ONE ORGANIZATION IN WHICH TO COMPETE.

A DUAL-REGISTERED ATHLETE WHO ENTERS AS A USA SWIMMING MEMBER BY COMPLYING WITH THE ENTRY INFORMATION BELOW WHO THEN WISHES TO CHANGE REPRESENTATION MUST SUBMIT A USMS DECLARATION OF INTENT FORM TO THE MEET DIRECTOR NO LATER THAN THE USMS ENTRY DEADLINE.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Competition 25 yards, 6 lanes. The length of the competition course without a bulkhead is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1. Starting end 5'4" deep, turning end 4'4" deep. Two lanes for masters will be used for masters and four lanes for age group swimmers.

CONTINUOUS WARM-UP: Continuous warm-up available in the dive tank.

TIMING SYSTEM: The primary timing system will be automatic timing. Times from this competition will be eligible for USMS records and Top 10 consideration, but not for world records.

RULES: Current USMS rules will govern the meet.

MAAPP: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the [USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy \("MAAPP"\)](#), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

ELIGIBILITY: All participants must be age 18 or older and be currently registered members of U.S. Masters Swimming or another World Aquatics federation. Foreign registered swimmers must provide proof of current membership in their country's Masters Swimming governing body.

RECOGNITION – LOCAL JURISDICTION PROCEDURE

This event is a USMS-sanctioned competition and is governed by the [USMS Interim Policy on Participation in the Men's/Open and Women's Competition Categories and Eligibility for Official Recognition Programs](#). Participation in sanctioned events is permitted in the competition category that aligns with a member's gender identity and/or expression.

At this event:

- A member may participate in the competition category that matches their gender identity and will be eligible to receive Local Recognition Program recognition in the Women's category in accordance with applicable law and/or facility-use agreements. Only swimmers assigned female at birth are eligible for National Recognition Programs (such as

USMS records, Top 10 times, and All-American and All-Star honors) in the women's category.

- All members, regardless of sex assigned at birth or gender identity, may participate in the Men's/Open category and are eligible to receive recognition in the Men's/Open category.

Eligibility determinations are handled administratively by USMS and will not be adjudicated onsite by meet personnel. All members must comply with applicable law and facility rules while onsite.

AGE DETERMINATION DATE: May 16, 2026

AGE GROUPS FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: 18-24, 25-29, ... in 5-yr increments as high as needed

AGE GROUPS FOR RELAYS: Relay age group is determined by the age of the youngest relay member: 18+, 25+, 35+, 45+, and up in 10-year increments as high as needed.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- **Entry Deadline:** Entries must be submitted online by 11:59 PM (PST) Tuesday, May 5, 2026.
- **Relay Entry Card** must be submitted to the clerk of course by the announced deadline. Mixed relays require two men and two women.
- **Entry limits:** Swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) individual events and one (1) freestyle and/or one (1) medley relay event.
- **Entry Fees:** \$15.00 surcharge PLUS \$4.50 per individual event. No charge for relays, but relay-only swimmers must enter online by the entry deadline. PNA swimmers who need financial assistance for entry fees may make a request from the [PNA Wiggin Fund](#).
- **Entry time** required for all events. Estimates are okay.
- **Deck entries:** No race day deck entries accepted.
